

The HAC building is located in one of the city's dividing axles. The building has been design to act not only as a social catalyst between two different areas of the city, but also as an interchanger of people and ideas.


For this purpose, this project proposes two individual accesses to the different main roads which come together in a central plaza that leads the visitors through the different uses the building offers.

Workshops are located in the top floors, as spaces that need previous knowledge to be accessed. Outdoors activities requiring more space will take place in the rooftop.
