
## The HOUSE OF ARTS & CULTURE The Lebanese-Omani Centre

Location The site is located on the border between the city district and the high speed road.

Permeability Exploring the idea of a dynamic and vivacious centre we propose a building with a high degree

of permeability.

Appearance The building sits sovereign on the site and fronts all directions.

Courtyard The scheme deals with the traditional courtyard houses. All functions are orientated towards the

inner courtyard which acts as the hub of the HOUSE. It offers a bright atmosphere in the whole

building with sensitive nuances of daylight.

The Performance and Conference Hall is the cultural heart of the building. As a half sunken

element it is embedded inbetween the other functions.

Foyer The foyer is an inviting open space which is splitted up into two levels. The lower part is partly


uncovered in order to achieve interaction.


Floor heights The section shows different ceiling heights for different functions.

Structure The building is conceived as an exposed white concrete building referring to the traditional

stone material.

Energy The walls and ceilings provide a sufficient amount of mass for thermal absorption.
